



Registration

Quilt Entries – There is no entry fee. All entries must be clean, smoke free, and odor free. A sleeve for hanging is appreciated but not mandatory.

Pre-Registration – We encourage you to email or mail “a copy” of your registration form by March 16, 2019 to help speed registration.

Limit – There is no limit per exhibitor. However, only 1 entry per Class Category may be judged.

Sales – the entry owner sets the item price or value. The Maple Festival adds an additional 20% for the sales price to cover building rental expenses. All judged items must remain in the festival exhibit for the duration of the festival. If sold, arrangements will be made to deliver to the buyer. Entries for sale and not judged are displayed if space is available.

Judging – The fire hall is closed during judging. No staff or volunteers participate in the judging. Judges reserve the right to recategorize an entry and to not award a premium. The judge's decision is final.

2019 Exhibitor Categories

1. **Antique / Heirloom** (Not Judged - for display only) - Older than 50 years or special family heirloom. Include a separate sheet with information about the significance of the quilt.
2. **Accessories / Home Decorating** - Hand or machine quilted: pillows, framed works, pot holders, table runners, purses, etc. (factory-quilted fabric will not be accepted).

CLASS Categories (cont.)

3. **Appliqué** - Hand or machine quilted.
(a. Bed size - b. Other*)
4. **Embroidery** - Hand or machine quilted.
(a. Bed size - b. Other*)
5. **First Quilt (new quilter)** - Hand or machine quilted, any type. (a. Bed size - b. Other*)
6. **Mixed** - Hand or machine quilted. Two or more techniques of equal importance to the piece. (a. Bed size - b. Other*)
7. **Pieced** - Hand quilted.
(a. Bed size - b. Other*)
8. **Pieced** - Machine quilted
(a. Bed size - b. Other*)
9. **Theme** - Represents history and significance of the region - includes maple, mountains, pictorial, fall foliage, natural resources, Amish, bike trail, covered bridges, etc.
(a. Bed size - b. Other*)
10. **Top (unfinished - e.g. pieced but not quilted)** - Any technique, any type, Bed size or Other*
11. **Whole cloth** - Hand or machine quilted - pre-printed fabric is permitted
(a. Bed size - b. Other*)
12. **Youth** - Hand or machine quilted.
(a. Age 12 and under - b. Age 13 - 19)

*Note: Bed size = king, queen, full, or twin. Other = crib, throw, any size wall hanging

All exhibits to be judged must be completed by the exhibitor during the time period since the last quilt show entered and must be entered in the name of the person making or producing the exhibit. Entries will be judged on a point system on general appearance, design and composition, and workmanship. Premiums will not be awarded if quilts in a category do not meet quality criteria.

But the Maple Festival is not, in any way, responsible for accidents, loss or damage by water, fire, theft, or otherwise, whatever may be the cause or extent of the damage or loss.
